To: All Parents of Grades 1-8

Preparations for the new school year are in full swing. Attached is a list of some of the basic supplies which your child(ren) will need in grades 1 through 5 (only). Please label the items with your child's name, whenever possible.

We will be selling the Hebrew notebooks (*Machbarot*) and Manhattan Special notebooks (for First Grade).

- Our PTA will be giving each student in grades 2-8 a JFS homework assignment pad at the beginning of the year. The homework pads are mandatory for grades 3-6.

We look forward to welcoming all of our students back on the first day of school, Thursday, September 3, 2015.

***Teachers in grades 6-8 will advise the students at the start of the school year as to what supplies will be required.**

***Students in all grades are requested to bring in 3 boxes of tissues at the beginning of the year, and to continue to bring them in, as needed, during the year. Thank you.**

Grade 1 – Hebrew

Grade 1 – English
