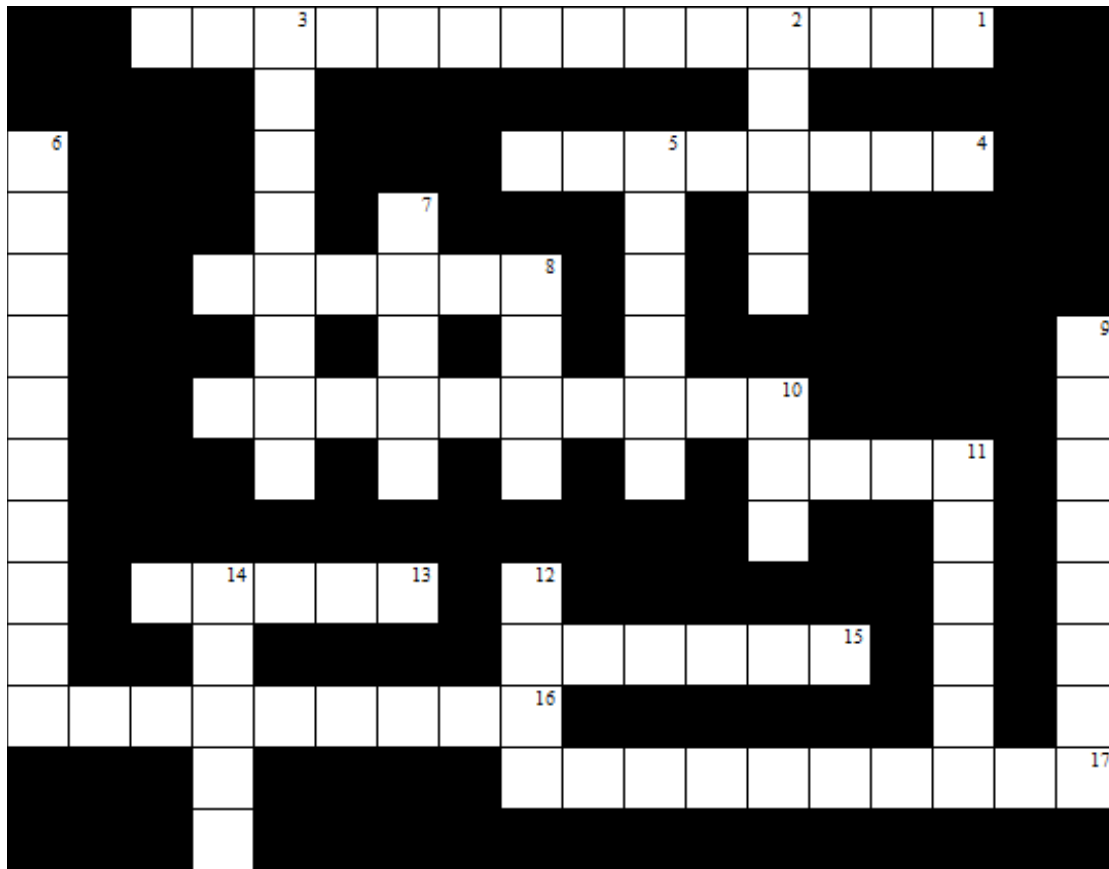

4. The amount of Jews who died in the second battle. (י')

16. Something that happened to the nation in the battlefield. (י"י)
8. Amount of years Eli judged the Jewish nation. (ה"י)
15. The wife of Pinchas gave her child this name. (א"ב)

8. The elders suggested this be brought from the battlefield to help them fight the Plishtim. (ג')
5. When the Plishtim first saw the *aron* they said, “Woe is to us.” (ו')
