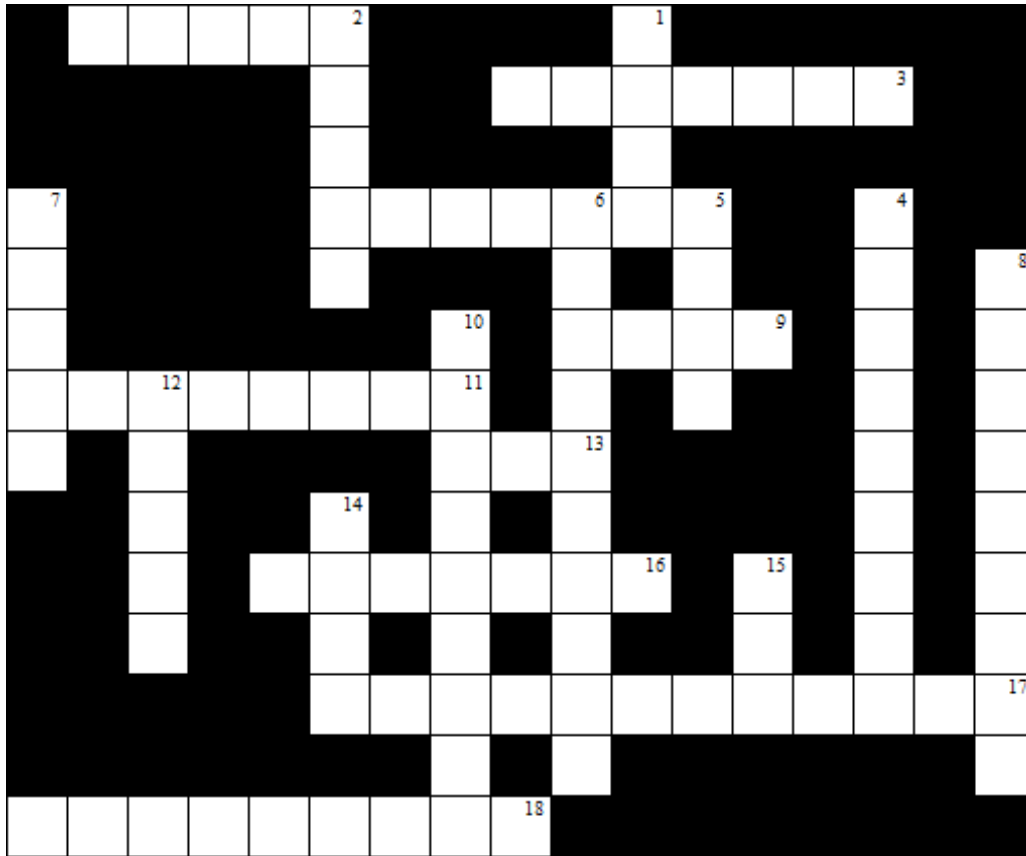

11. "Come up to us." (י')
