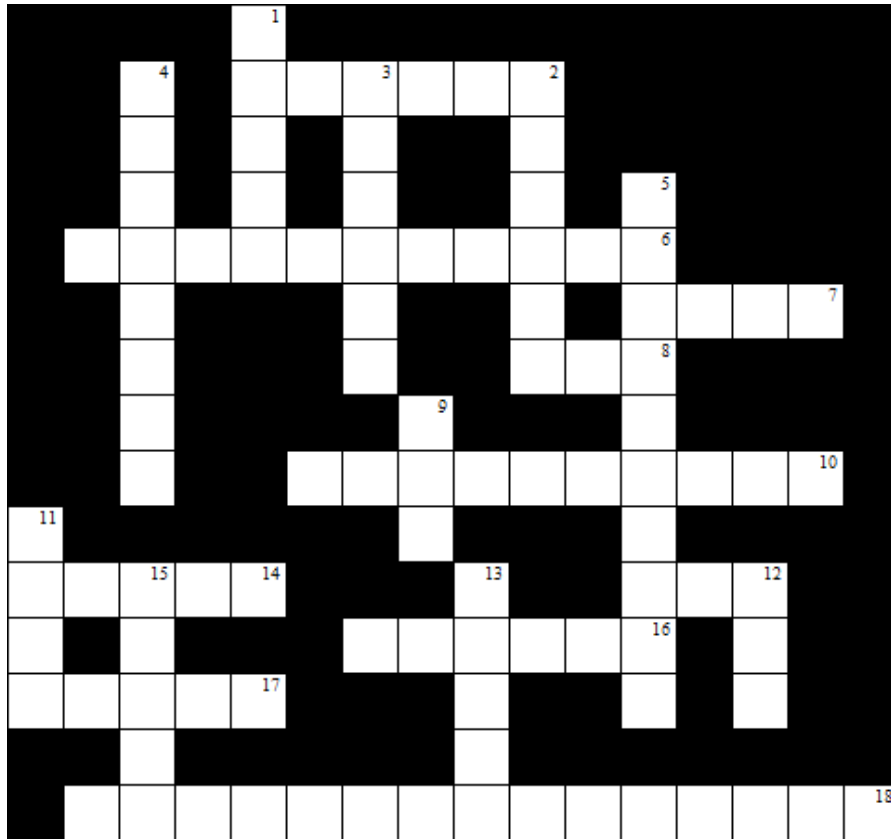

ACROSS

17. "I have remembered" what Amalek did to Yisroel. (ב)
 6. "And you shall not have pity on him." (ג)
 12. Shaul was told to kill everyone from a man to a "woman." (ג)
 14. Hashem said, "I have regretted" that I made Shaul king. (א"י)
 2. Shaul went out to greet Shmuel and said "I have fulfilled" the word of Hashem. (ג"י)
 8. Shaul blamed this group for having pity on the sheep and cattle. (ט"ו)
 18. Even if you are small in your own eyes, "you are the head of the tribes of Israel." (י"ז)
 7. Shmuel accused Shaul of going after this in his battle against Amalek. (ט"י)
 16. Shmuel told Shaul it is better to listen than to bring one of these. (כ"ב)
 10. Shmuel told Shaul that since he had rejected the word of Hashem therefore Hashem had done this. (ג"ג)

11. Group of people who were warned to go away from Amalek so that they won't be destroyed when Amalek is attacked. (ו)
 12. King of Amalek who Shaul had pity on and did not kill. (ט)
 5. After Shaul told Shmuel he had fulfilled the word of Hashem, Shmuel asked Shaul about this sound which he heard in his ears. (י"ד)
 2. A word Shmuel used to describe the nation of Amalek. (י"ח)
 13. "I have sinned." (כ"ד)
 1. When Shmuel left Shaul and held onto his garment – this was the result. (כ"ז)
 4. "The Eternal One of Israel" will not lie. (ט"ט)
 15. This is how Agag was brought before Shmuel. (כ"ב)
 3. When Agag was brought before Shmuel he spoke about "the bitterness of death" that was near. (כ"ב)
 9. Shaul told Agag that just as he had made other women barren so too should this woman become barren. (ג"ג)
