


## שְׁמוּאֵל א' פָּרָק ט"ז



### ACROSS

- 16.** Hashem told Shaul to take this in his hand and say he had come to bring a sacrifice to Hashem. (ב')
- 14.** When Shmuel came to Beit Lechem these people hurried toward him. (ד')
- 12.** Hashem told Shmuel not to look at Eliav's appearance and "his tall height" for I have rejected him. (ז')
- 7.** Regarding both Avinadav and Shamah, Hashem told Shmuel "also this one" Hashem has not chosen. (ה'-ט')
- 5.** What Dovid was busy doing while Yishai was presenting his other children to Shmuel. (א"י)
- 17.** Dovid's color is described as being like this. (ב"י)
- 1.** When Dovid appeared before Shmuel Hashem told Shmuel "Get up and anoint him" for this is him. (ב"י)
- 18.** After he was anointed, "a spirit" of Hashem descended upon Dovid. (ג"י)
- 19.** Shaul is described as feeling this way about Dovid. (א"כ)

### DOWN

- 10.** Hashem asked Shmuel how much longer are you going to do this for Shaul? (א')
- 2.** Hashem told Shmuel to fill his horn/jug with this and go anoint the son of Yishai in Beit Lechem. (א')
- 8.** Shmuel was afraid Shaul would do this to him if he found out that he had gone to anoint a new king. (ב')
- 17.** Name of Yishai's oldest son who Shmuel thought should be the new king. (ו')
- 4.** For a person sees with their eyes, but Hashem sees "to the heart." (ז')
- 6.** After Yishai presented seven sons to Shmuel, he was asked this question by Shmuel. (א"י)
- 3.** According to Yishai, this son still remained and was shepherding with the sheep. (א"י)
- 9.** After the spirit of Hashem descended upon Dovid, this descended upon Shaul and frightened him. (ז')
- 11.** It was suggested to Shaul that a person who knows to do this could be found and help him with his bad spirit. (ז"ט)
- 15.** One of the descriptions of Dovid was that he was "a strong warrior." (ה"י)
- 13.** Part of Yishai's gift to Shaul included "a donkey load of bread." (ב')
