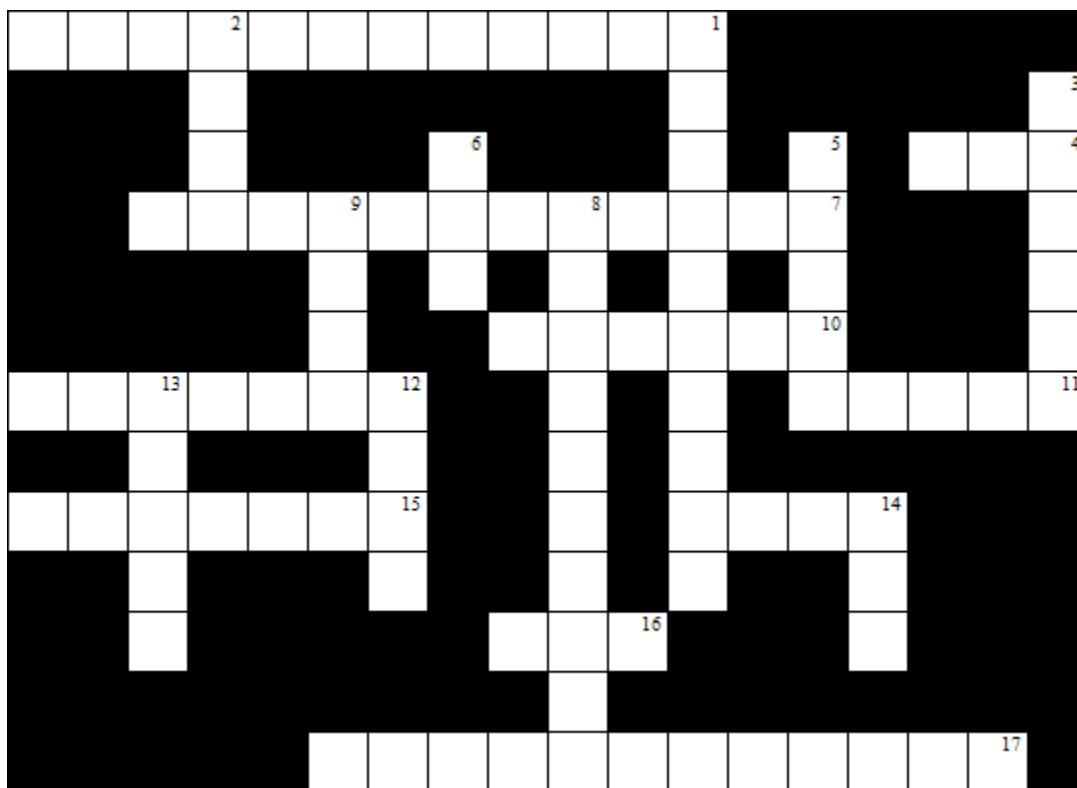

ACROSS
