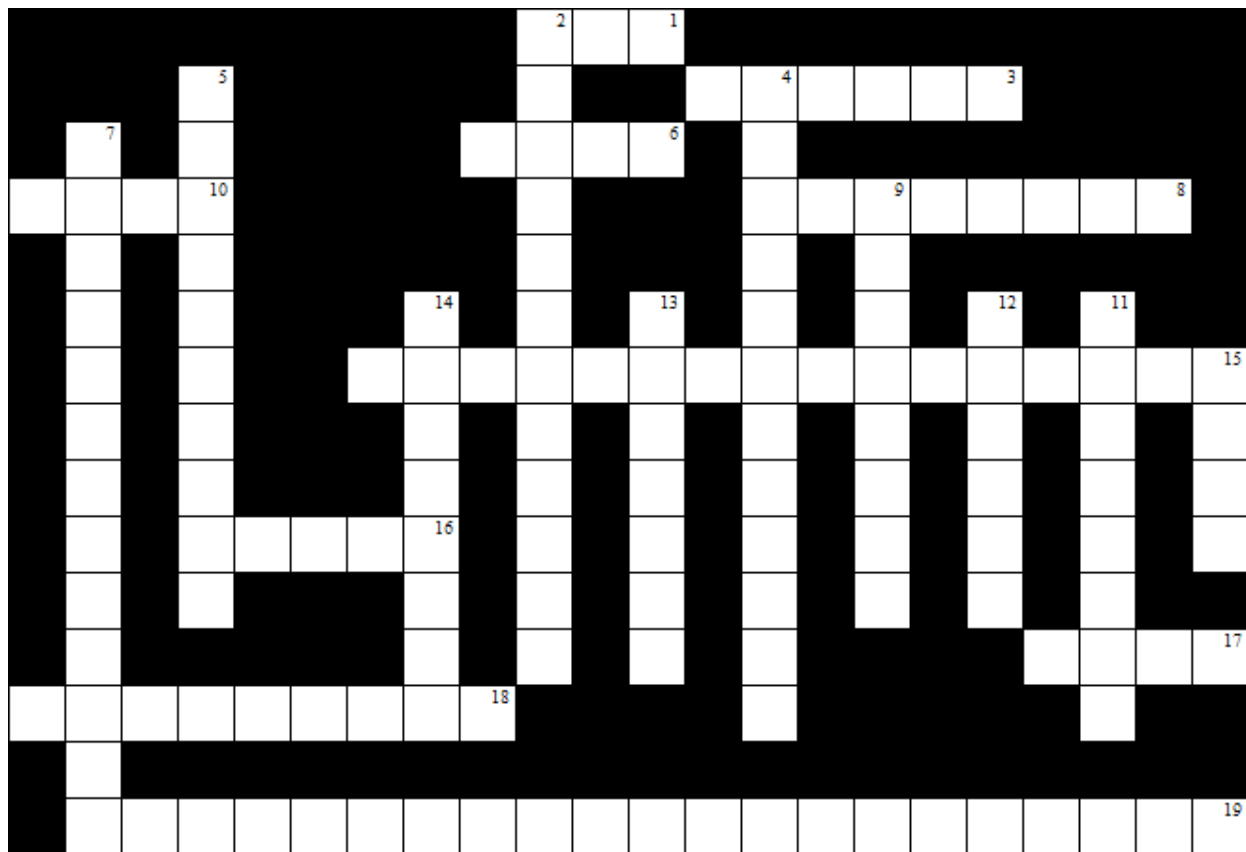

ACROSS

- 19.** Dovid asked Yehonatan these three questions about Shaul's behavior towards him. (א')
- 17.** Dovid swore there is this amount of space between him and death. (ג')
- 1.** If Shaul would say this word when being told Dovid went to a family gathering, that was a sign that all was well with Dovid. (ו')
- 10.** Yehonatan asked Dovid to come to this private location to discuss how he will let Dovid know what happened. (א'י')
