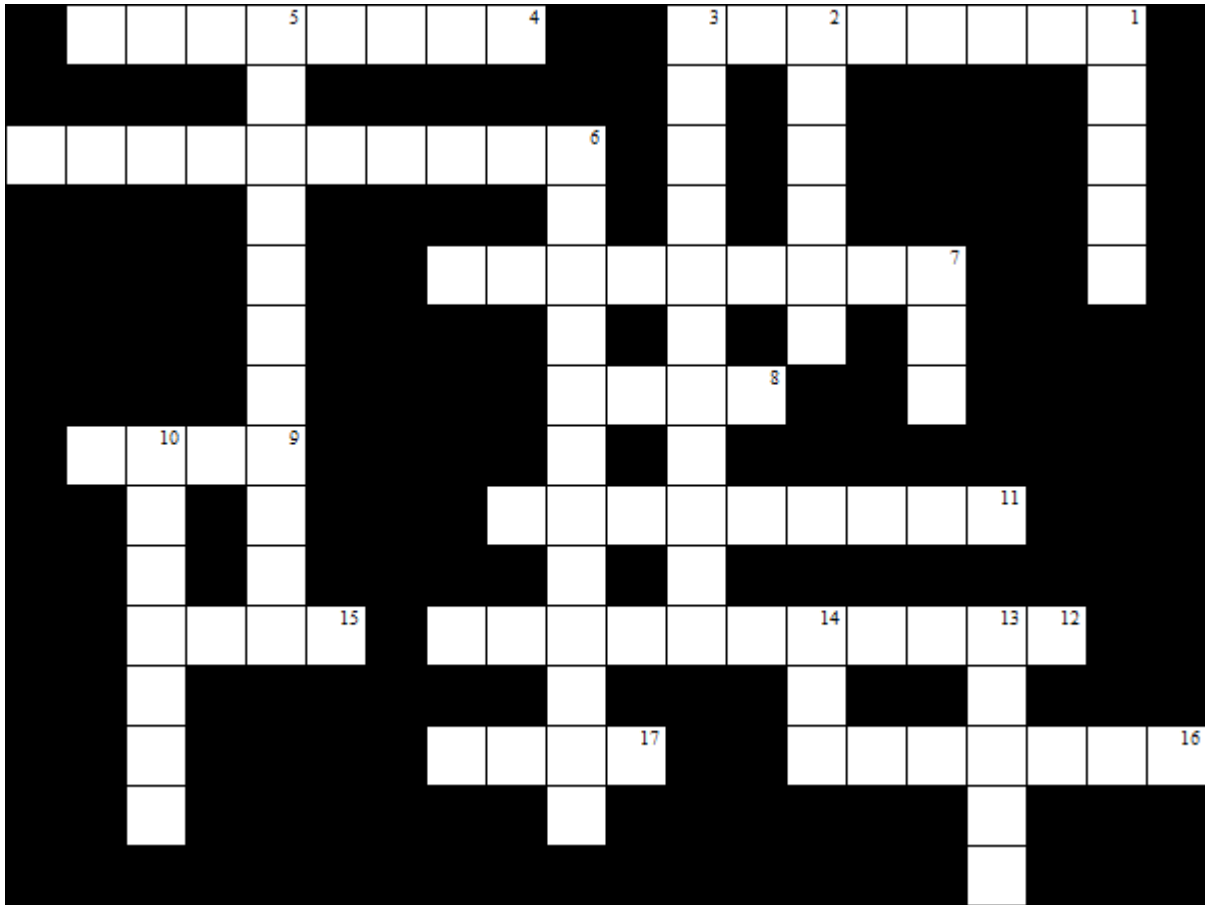

- 11.** Amount of people Shaul took with him as he went to search for Dovid. (ב')
- 9.** Hebrew word for cave. (ג')
- 7.** These people were in the cave in which Shaul had entered. (ג')
