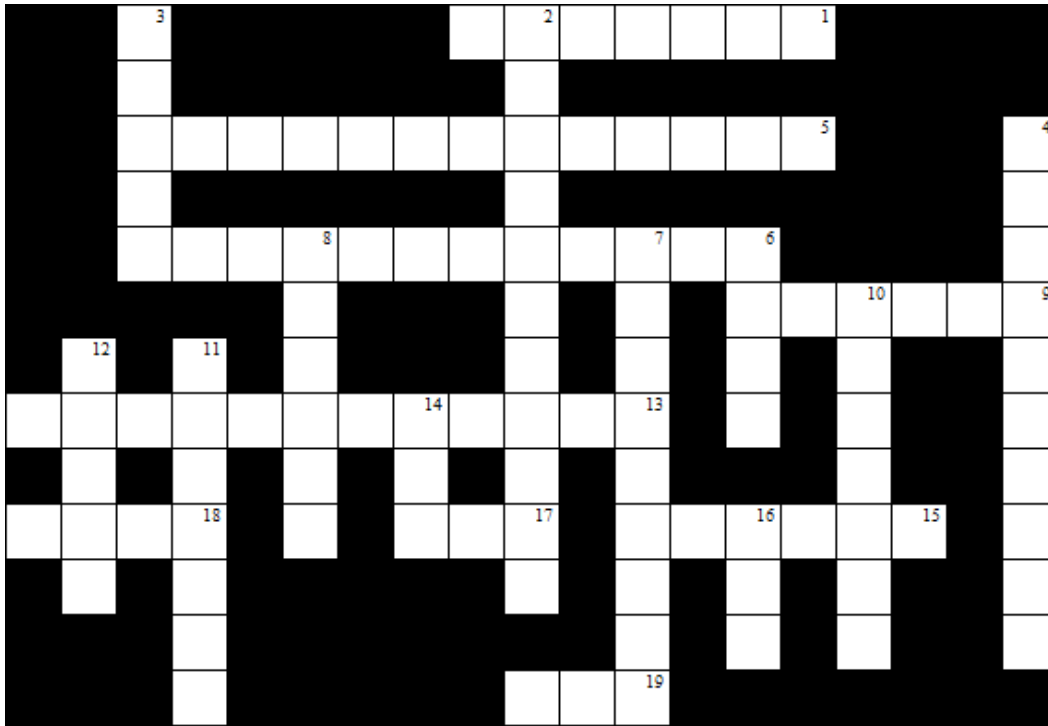

ACROSS

- 15.** Achish stayed in this part of the camp with Dovid and his men. (ב')
- 6.** The Plishti officers asked Achish this question when they first saw Dovid and his men. (ג')
