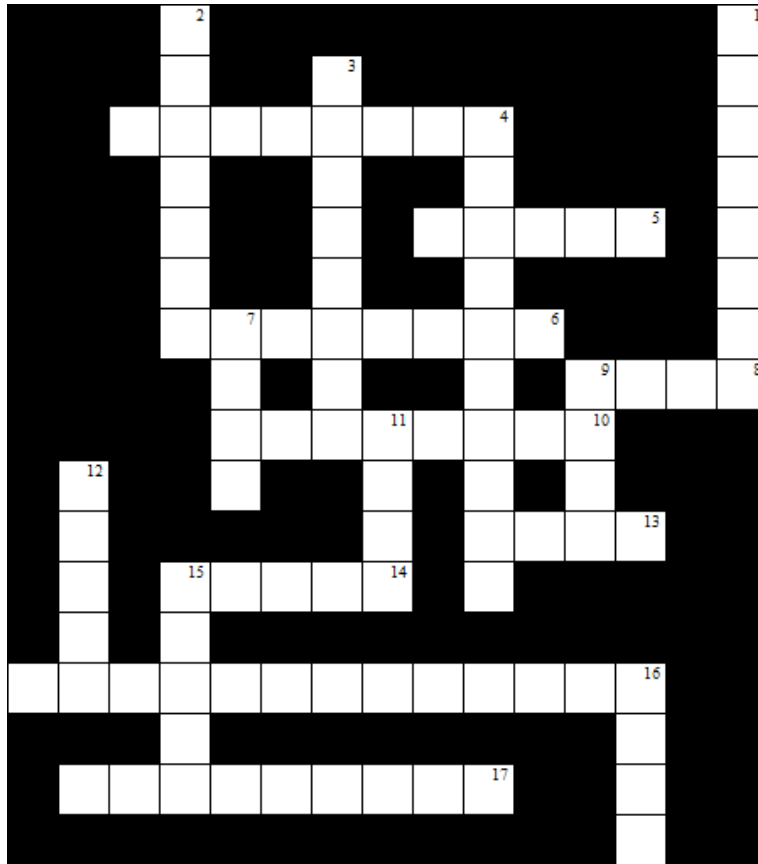

ACROSS

- 5.** What Dovid's men wanted to do to him after their children were captured. (ר')
